	GERMANY	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- LH/Lufthansa (direct flights to Frankfurt):o Daily flight from São Pauloo Should resume direct flights from Rio de Janeiro as of June, three times a week <p>https://www.lufthansa.com/xx/en/flight-information.html</p> <p><i>Lufthansa is currently only permitted to carry the following booked passengers on departures from countries in the Virus Variant areas (Brazil concerned): Passengers with German nationality or passengers with a valid residence permit in Germany (upon presentation of a German registration certificate) + Passengers of other nationalities but only if they have a connecting flight to a "Non-Schengen state" and do not leave the transit area in Frankfurt or Munich (Exception are flights from Portugal - here no passengers of other nationalities with connecting flights in Schengen- or Non-Schengen-states are generally permitted)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- LATAM: direct flights from São Paulo to Frankfurt: No indication so far for April 2021 <p>Negative Test (PCR, antigen, RT-LAMP or TMA) max 48h before entry in German, English or French + mandatory quarantine</p> <p>https://www.bundesregierung.de/breg-de/themen/coronavirus/ausbreitung-coronavirus-1716188</p>

	NETHERLANDS	<p>KLM (to Amsterdam): Daily direct flights from São Paulo and five times per week from Rio de Janeiro. Even if there is a ban on flights from the United Kingdom, Cabo Verde, the Dominican Republic, South Africa and all the countries in South America until 1 April 2021, there are some exemptions : People returning to the Netherlands by aircraft, if they are Dutch nationals or residents of the Netherlands. This also applies to nationals and residents of other EU/Schengen countries, but only if they are transiting to another Schengen country and not if the Netherlands is their final destination.</p>

	PORTUGAL	<p>TAP (to Lisbon): Suspension of any commercial flights to and from Brazil until at least 15 April.</p> <p>Humanitarian flight from Brazil to Portugal at the end of February.</p> <p>PCR test no more than 72h prior to departure</p> <p>https://covid19estamoson.gov.pt/#</p>
	SPAIN	<p>From 3rd February flights to Spain from Brazil are only allowed if occupied by: Spanish citizens, Andorran citizens, Holders of residence permits of Spain or Andorra (no visas), Passengers on international transit to a non-Schengen country with a stopover of less than 24 hours (without leaving the transit area of the Spanish airport)</p> <p>- Iberia (to Madrid): 10-11(LATAM)-12-13-14(LATAM)-15-17-18(LATAM)-19-21(LATAM)-22-24-25(LATAM)-26-28(LATAM)/04</p> <p>- Air Europa (to Madrid):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Direct from São Paulo: 10-13-17-20-24-27/04 ○ Direct from Salvador de Bahia: No direct flight so far ○ Direct from Recife + Fortaleza : Still TBC <p>- LATAM (direct flights to Madrid): No indication so far for April 2021</p> <p>PCR test no more than 72h prior to arrival.</p> <p>https://www.mscbs.gob.es/en/profesionales/saludPublica/ccayes/alertasActual/nCov/spth.htm</p>

	SWITZERLAND	<p>SwissAir (São Paulo-Zurich): 10-11-12-14-16-17-18-19-21-23-24-25-26-28-30/04</p> <p>Should increase of one day frequency in May and another frequency in June, resuming daily operations between São Paulo and Zurich</p> <p>https://www.swiss.com/brazil/EN</p> <p>PCR test is requested since 08/02</p> <p>Information on entry restrictions: https://www.sem.admin.ch/sem/en/home.html</p>
